

## **INSTALLATION STEPS**

- Underneath the rear of the vehicle, locate the left and right frame rails in line with the rear bumper brackets.
  Remove the (3) bolt/washer assemblies retaining the bumper to the frame rails on each side. Return only
  (2) of these bolt/washers assemblies to the vehicles owner for reinstallation should the hitch ever be removed.
  To ease installation, temporarily remove the rearmost exhaust hanger.
- 2. Lift and support the hitch in place on the frame rails. Holes in the hitch end brackets should line up with the existing weldnuts where bolts were removed. Fasten the hitch using existing fasteners as shown. Install supplied fasteners in the bottom of the frame rails as shown.
- 3. Torque all 10mm fasteners to 48 lb-ft.
