

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Remove the material in the cargo area where holes will be drilled. Mark the vehicle's centerline on the underside of the rear bumper. Hold the hitch in place centered and square on the vehicle. Position the hitch so there is a minimum of 1 1/2" between back of hitch ball and the plastic bumper cover.
- 2. Trim the plastic fascia and retainer as necessary. Hold the hitch in place on the vehicle and use it as a template to mark and drill all holes. Drill holes through the trunk floor for 3/8" fasteners, and holes through the bumper beam for 7/16" hardware.
- 3. Work (2) rectangular u-bolts into bumper as shown. Mount the hitch to the vehicle using fasteners as shown.
- 4. Torque all 3/8" fasteners to 45 lb-ft, and all 7/16" fasteners to 70 lb-ft. Do not use impact wrench on u-bolts...
- 5. Use silicone sealant to seal hardware installed through trunk floor.
- 6. Reinstall all contents removed in Step 1.
