

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Position the hitch against the vehicle's trunk and bumper as shown so hitch is centered and square with the vehicle. Remove plastic fascia where hitch contacts the bumper beam. Use the hitch as a template to mark and center punch (4) places in trunk floor and (2) places at the bumper beam.
- 2. Clear the trunk for drilling. Drill (4) places in trunk floor for 3/8" bolts, and (2) places in bumper beam for 7/16" bolts.
- 3. Mount hitch to vehicle as shown. Note that fender washers are placed inside trunk, opposite hitch. Use CM-SP102 spacers between hitch and corrugated trunk floor with longer 1-1/2" bolts at outside holes in trunk.
- 4. Torque all 3/8" fasteners to 45 lb-ft, and all 7/16" fasteners to 70 lb-ft.
- 5. Use silicone sealant to seal hardware installed through trunk floor.
- 6. Reinstall contents removed in Step 2.
