



INSTALL NOTES:

- DRILLING REQUIRED

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1) Remove spare tire from vehicle.
- 2) Wire fish the 1/2" x 1 1/2" carriage bolts and carriage spacers through side holes in frame and into the appropriate prepunched holes (hole locations may vary based on model years).
- 3) Raise the hitch into position, aligning with carriage bolts and fasten with corresponding offset spacer and 1/2" flange nut.
- 4) Using hitch as a template, drill the front holes to 1/2" on both sides of the frame.
- 5) Wire fish remaining 1/2" x 1 1/2" carriage bolts and carriage spacers through side holes in frame and into drilled holes in frame and fasten as shown.
- 6) Replace spare tire and torque all bolts to 110 lb.-ft.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
