



1. Enlarge access holes for square hole spacers with a die grinder.

Fishwire 7/16" bolts and spacers into vehicle frame for the (2) side plate mounting points on each side of the vehicle.





2. Place hitch underneath vehicle and route fishwire through side plate mounting holes. It may be necessary to use two people to raise the hitch into position. Remove fishwire and loosely secure mounting hardware to hold the hitch into position.

INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:

3. The passenger side plate will have limited access to secure fasteners. Use an 11/16" boxed end wrench to tighten hardware on this side.

The driver side plate can be secured using an 11/16" socket.

4. Torque all 7/16" fasteners to 70 ft-lbs.



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

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Enlarge access holes for square hole spacers with a die grinder. Fishwire 7/16" bolts and spacers into vehicle frame for the (2) side plate mounting points on each side of the vehicle.
- 2. Place hitch underneath vehicle and route fishwire through side plate mounting holes. It may be necessary to use two people to raise the hitch into position. Remove fishwire and loosely secure mounting hardware to hold the hitch into position.
